If the radio has desktop microphone the distance it will pick up is eight feet, if it is a regular mobile microphone the distance is fifteen feet. Tetra Tec will be performing school safety surveys that need to include EMA, Law Enforcement, and School Staff.

Mitchell gave an update on interoperability with Sumner Fire Department. Mitchell also recommends leaving all apparatus on 19 Fire 2 so there is no confusion when responding. Mitchell discussed the equipment transfer agreements.
