

RESOLUTION NO. 07-10-23-53

***A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN INABILITY TO IDENTIFY
AN ELIGIBLE AND WILLING APPOINTEE TO THE NEW HAMPTON
PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION***

WHEREAS, the city of New Hampton extends its zoning jurisdiction to the unincorporated areas of Chickasaw County within two miles of the city limits pursuant to *Iowa Code* section 414.23(1); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with *Iowa Code* section 414.23(2), the Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors thus shall appoint two members to the New Hampton Planning and Zoning Commission, including (1) a member of the Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors, or the Board's designee, who shall be a resident of the area outside the city limits over which the zoning jurisdiction is extended, and (2) a resident of the area outside the city limits over which the zoning jurisdiction is extended; and


WHEREAS, at least one of the two members of the New Hampton Planning and Zoning Commission appointed by the Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors also shall own land that is actively used for an agricultural purpose as defined in section 570A.1, except when such requirement prevents the identification of an eligible and willing appointee for at least six months; and

WHEREAS, for nearly twelve months the Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors has been unable to identify an eligible and willing appointee to the New Hampton Planning and Zoning Commission who owns land that is actively used for an agricultural purpose; and


WHEREAS, the failure to identify an eligible and willing appointee shall be determined independently for the New Hampton Planning and Zoning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors hereby declares an inability to identify an eligible and willing appointee to the New Hampton Planning and Zoning Commission who owns land that is actively used for an agricultural purpose.
